

OFF-PROPERTY HIKES

(must drive to)

INDEPENDENCE ROCK: is about a 40 minute drive from Breitenbush. It's a fairly easy trail with a great view at the top. 1.7 miles, easy to moderate. Ends with a beautiful view, out and back.

TAMOLITCH FALLS: (which has the famous Blue Pool) is about an hour drive from Breitenbush. This is a moderate trail, 200ft elevation gain, out and back, with some fun scrambling to get down to the pool if you wish. From Carmen Smith Reservoir (3.3 miles); from Trailbridge Reservoir (2.1 miles).

STAHLMAN POINT TRAIL: is a low, steady out and back uphill 4 mile trail meanders through younger Douglas-fir forest with occasional views of Detroit Reservoir as you near the end of the trail. 30 min drive from Breitenbush. Moderately challenging, 1,338 mile elevation gain, some fire damage.

DOMEROCK TRAIL: a challenging 9.4 mile out and back hike, with a 3,297 ft elevation gain. 17 miles from Breitenbush, but 50 min drive. Some fire damage, but ends at a beautiful bald rock lookout over the whole valley.

PAMELIA LAKE TRAIL: Check out this 4.4-mile out-and-back trail near Idanha, Oregon, 45 mins from Breitenbush. Moderately challenging route, featuring old growth trees and ending at a beautiful lake, it takes an average of 2 h 5 min to complete, and links to more trails. Requires a day use or overnight pass, see fs.usda.gov for details.

WOODPECKER RIDGE TRAIL: This is a 3.3-mile out-and-back trail near Idanha, Oregon, with beautiful seasonal wildflowers. A moderately challenging route, most finish in 1.45 hours. This trail is great for birding, and usually unpopulated. Some fire damage, some sunny exposure.

NEARBY HIKES

(can walk to)

NF 2231: Closest forest service road to walk on, it branches right off the main road in. Some fire damage, slow and steady uphill, endless options branching off. Creek access at a few points.

NF 4693: Another forest service road that branches off right at the bridge. Uphill, meandering through forest, some burn damage. Also links to more roads and options for exploration.

Breitenbush Campground: Can be inhabited by campers, but also lovely for walking through. Beautiful old growth trees and well-maintained forests offer a park-like experience. Great for young ones.

NF 46: This is the main road you drove in on, and it is great for walking, as there is not much traffic and it is green by the road where the Breitenbush turnoff is. Go left or right for more forest service road off-shoots. Can be accessed from the gravel road that led you here, or through the staff side road, by taking a left turn after the bridge.

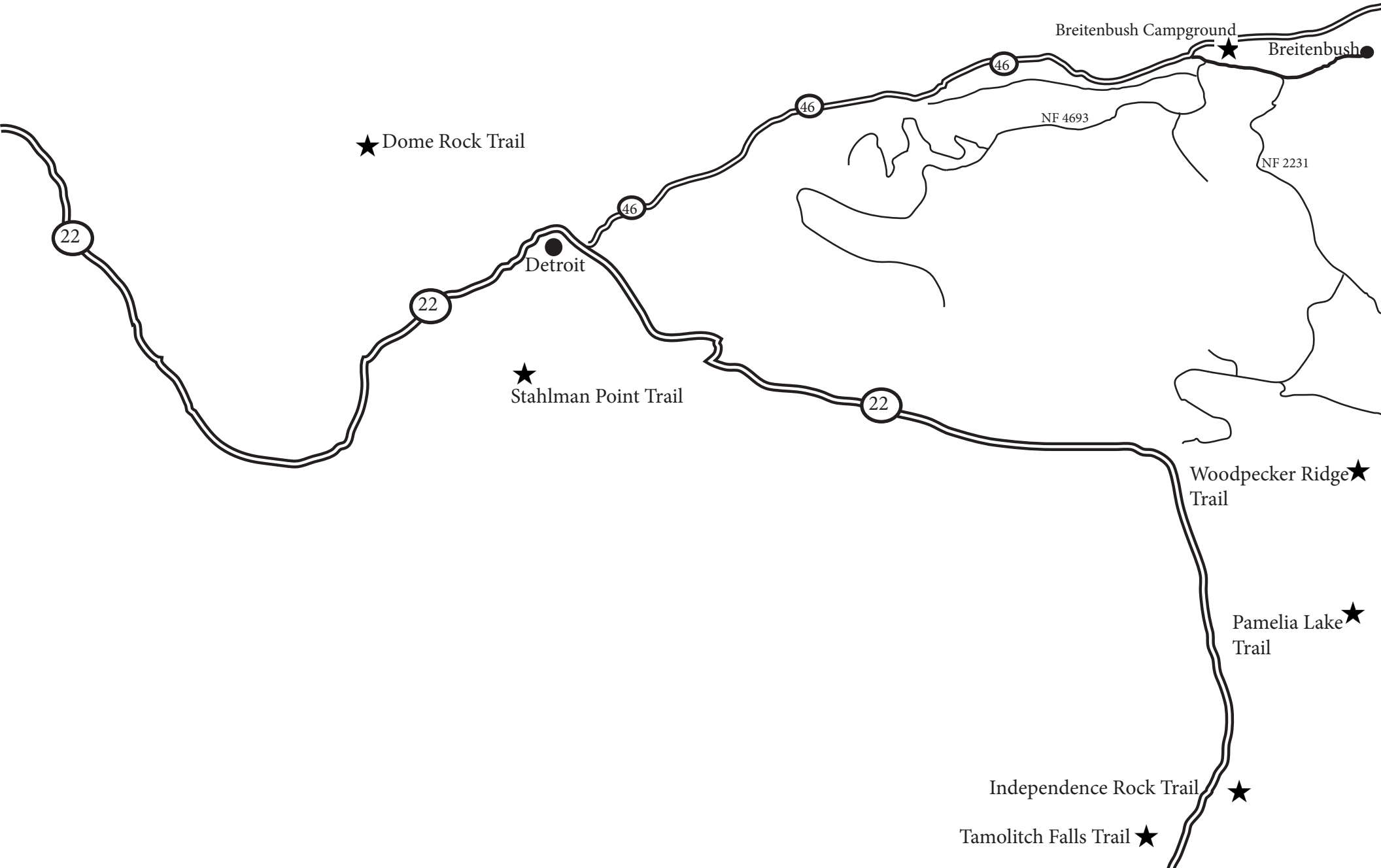
